DIVISIONS: This meet is open to collegiate teams. Unattached and Club athletes must meet the entry

standards in order to participate.

ENTRIES: Submit entries online via website: www.directathletics.com. Direct Athletics will be open for

entries on Wednesday, March 11. Entry deadline will be at midnight on Tuesday, March 17, when the website will be closed. No additions will be accepted after this deadline. **Please see**

ENTRY FEE: Entry Fees for **unattached/club athletes** are \$20.00 per individual athlete per event (example

2 events entered = \$40), and \$20.00 per relay team. Unattached entry fees must be paid online at the time of registration (see below information). Entry Fees for registered collegiate teams are \$260.00 per gender, or \$520.00 for combined teams or \$20.00 per athlete which ever is less. Collegiate Entry Fees must be paid prior to the start of competition. RULES: NCAA rules will apply. The NO false start rule will be enforced. All running races are timed

section finals. All field events are 3 attempt preliminaries with 8 advancing to a 3 attempt final. In the case where numbers are excessively large, we may allow only 4 attempts with no

final.

PRACTICE TIMES: Hornet stadium and the throwing venues will be available for pre-meet practice on Friday,

March 20 from **5:00 to 7:00pm**.

FACILITIES: Hornet Stadium is furnished with a 400 meter MONDO surface. The horizontal jumps and

javelin approach are also made of MONDO. On all MONDO surfaces, the required spike length and type is ¼ inch pyramid or x-mas tree spikes. **NO needle spikes are permitted.** The throwing circles are of brushed concrete. **We will throw the shot put and discus out of two**

different circles concurrently.

WARM-UP AREA: Hornet Stadium and the Alex G. Spanos Sports Complex has a 400 meter MONDO

warm-up track. All general warm-ups must be conducted on the warm-up track.

EVENT CHECK-IN: All running event/relay teams must check-in with the clerk of the course 30 minutes prior to

the event. Field event competitors will check-in at the respective event site at least 45 minutes

prior to event.

TIMING: Fully automatic timing with Finish Lynx.

WEIGH INS: Weigh-ins will be conducted from 7:30am to 11:00am with first preference for the **hammer and**

javelins. All implements will be impounded and delivered to the event area for warm-up and competition. No implements will be certified for competition if they are not dropped off

by 11:00am! Location TBA.

RESTROOMS: The facilities are located on the back side of the west and east grandstand.

LOCKER ROOMS: Locker rooms are not available.

FIELD EVENT MINIMUM **DISTANCE LINES:**

All competitors will have their first legal throw or jump measured. All others attempts will only be measured if they meet the Minimum Distance Requirement.

IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION: Change from last year!

STANDARDS:

COLLEGIATE ENTRY: In an attempt to maintain the quality and timeliness of the meet, each school is limited to 3 entries per event and one team per relay. They do not have to meet the entry standards. One additional entry per individual event may be allowed. If you enter 4, all the athletes entered must meet the entry standard listed below! If no entry standard is listed you may enter up to 4 athletes in individual events. All entries will require a seed mark, location, and date. Last years marks are acceptable.

UNATTACHED ATHLETES:

Must meet the Open entry standards listed below. All entries will require a seed mark location, and date. You must pay your entry fee on-line at the time you submit your entry or it will not be accepted. There may be a \$3.00 fee for Credit/Debit charges.

VERY IMPORTANT:

Your entry will be verified for accuracy. If it cannot be verified via the internet your entry will not be accepted and you will forfeit (no refund) your entry fee! You will not be notified if your entry is not accepted. DO NOT ENTER WITH A FALSIFIED MARK!
