We are down to the wire regarding the deadline to register your team/club without the \$100 late fee. If you have not already done so, you have only one week left to register your club for the annual \$75 fee. After next Saturday April 30, 2011, the cost will go up to \$175. The additional \$100 late fee goes directly to the National Headquarters in Indianapolis, IN. The Pacific Association receives absolutely no benefit from this late fee. To those not registered, please do send in your team registration immediately!!

There is a change to the PAC Championship meet regarding the Subbantam Division. The 1500m, 800m, turbo javelin and shot put can only be contested by 7 and 8 year olds born in years 2003 and 2004; same as our Junior Olympic Championship meet contested June 24-26, 2011 at Granada High School in Livermore. You will therefore, not be able to enter your younger athletes in these events. Because we have always allowed any age subbantams enter our PAC meet, we are creating another division called Pre-subbantams. The Pre-sub events will be the same as in previous years. That consists of the 100m, 200m, 400m, long jump and 4x100. The website change will take place shortly.

Please be aware that at the Junior Olympic Championship track meet, the Pre-sub athletes will not be allowed to compete in that track meet at all. You will have to wait two weeks later for the Subbantam Championship meet July 2, 2011 at Granada High School in Livermore.

Please register your athletes under your club as soon as possible. Remember, they are free agents to be easily swooped up by another team even if they have competed for your team earlier this season. Nothing legally can be done about it. This issue has come up already and has been brought to our attention.
