LDR BUDGET - 2014

Income

Banquet - \$1000 (It is listed as income because the BOA needs to know there is money to cover it and it does not come from the general budget. The Exec Committee knows this money actually comes from the extra \$100 charged each Road Championship. Race Prize money

Road GP - \$40,500 (\$1000 allocated to LDR Banquet; \$350 to AADP) XC GP - \$10540

Expenses

Race Prize money Road GP - \$39,150 XC GP - \$9940 End of Year Prize Money Road GP - \$15,000 XC GP - \$8000 Ultra GP - \$3000 Travel Funds (AADP) Road - \$1000 (\$650 of travel funding comes from the General Fund) XC - \$1000 (\$400 of travel funding comes from the General Fund) Ultra - \$1000 (If there is no travel then you need to ask the BOA if it is ok to lump into GP.)

RULES CHANGES

ULTRA GRAND PRIX "AGE GROUP" TEAM SCORING PROPOSAL

(This was initially scheduled to be voted on at the Zippy LDR but due to low attendance it was decided to wait for this meeting.)

To add 3 more team divisions designated as Age Group, restricted to ages to be set at the beginning of each year by the MUT subcommittee, somewhat like the division between long and short Road races. There would be one division for each of Men, Women and Mixed. The age restriction may be different for the 3 divisions.

Keep the current divisions designated as Open, with no age restrictions.

An Age Group runner may be scored either as an Age Group or Open runner but may be scored only once. A runner under the Age Group restriction may be scored only as an Open runner. This is the same as 'moving down' in road and XC races.

Following are some numbers derived from the 2013 Jed Smith and Way Too Cool results (includes only PA members).

	Total finishers	Under 40	40+	Under 50	50+
Men	92	21	71	49	43
Womer	n 38	10	28	27	11
Mixed	131	31	99	76	54

My guess from these numbers is that we would choose 50 for men and mixed. For women, 40 would probably be best in order to have enough Age Group women.

The term Age Group is based on UltraRunning Magazine's Age Group Perfomances for the Year (UR uses 50 for both men and women).
