- Treasurer's Report – expenses / budget approved
- USATF Annual Meeting / Convention
 - Will be held at Silver Legacy (cheaper hotel rates at Circus Circus)
 - Group code = 1USTRAK (\$39 Sun-Thur / \$60 Fri-Sat) = 800-648-5010
 - Friday, 7:00 am is PA Caucus
 - Wednesday night at General Session – reorganization vote – all delegates must be present for this vote
 - Thursday, Friday, Saturday = hospitality suite set up by Fred Baer for any of us to use
- USATF Reorganization
 - Pod plans to request a roll call prior to vote at Convention
 - Wednesday at 3 pm at Convention is a meeting to explain restructuring package
 - ACTION: Fred Baer and Pod need to meet to discuss concern that Nor Cal JCs don't have a vote
- Grievances
 - LDR – still not known if grievance was challenge all the way to the national office
 - PA grievance – national office still looking over notes from their various executive BOA meetings
- 2009 California Relays
 - Moved to Sac State and will be contested on May 9
 - Further discussion to combine with Adidas Carson and Golden West and move all meets to June 13 thus making the meet a part of the Golden Spike Relays tour
 - NBC TV would air meet

- Complication is Save Mart promotional schedule duplication with NASCAR race on same weekend
 - If meets do not get combined then California Relays will stay on May 9
 - If meets do not get combined than Golden West will stay on June 13 and merge with PAC
- 2009 Golden West meet
 - See above ... possible opportunity to either combine with California Relays or combine with PAC
- 2009 Junior Olympic Cross Country Championships
 - Everything moving forward
 - John Mansoor is officially the Meet Director
 - Working on the creation of the LOC
- 2009 Senior Games
 - Need to ensure officials mark their calendar
 - 65-100+ age group compete 1st week (Aug 5-8)
 - 59-64 age group compete 2nd week (Aug 9-11)
 - Location: Stanford
 - 5K and 10K run & race walk courses are still being laid out
- 2010 Junior Olympic Track Championships
 - Bid had been submitted
 - On sight visit with 5 people from national committee who attended
 - Second visit required due to construction at venue location; Doug Logan attended second visit
 - PA is the only association bidding to host meet
- 2010 Masters Track Championship
 - Proceeding
- 2010 Open / Masters Cross Country Championship
 - Bid by Aggies? to host meet; Peanut going to Reno but needs to go in front of PA Exec Board before he can pitch to National Committee
- 2011 World Masters Track Championship
 - Proceeding; venues / hotels secured
- Strategic Plan
 - Move BOA meeting to 4 instead of 5 meetings a year
 - Meet in February and combine with Jan BOA meeting
 - Strategic Planning Session (occurs once every 4 years)
 - Date: Monday, February 16
 - Time: 10:00 – 5:00 pm
 - Location: Sheraton Grand, 13th & J St., Sacramento
