Treasurer's Report

- Drop in 2008 membership results in loss of income of \$16K
- Golden West track meet also lost fair amount of money
- One time legal expense to prepare grievance against USATF national office of \$4K
- Sanctions up first time over \$100K in a single year
- Income from youth meets came in at expected levels
- Overall loss was \$10K \$20K (NOTE: the 2008 budget was approved with an expectation of a loss)
- Lloyd will rework the spreadsheet to provide a more comprehensive summary in March 2009 meeting

Grievances

- Association grievance
 - o PA vs. USATF national office regarding 2012 Olympic trials selection
 - o PA has 1-year from 1st time info becomes available

- Project 30 report was released this past week; one of the suggested changes is to change the Olympic qualifiers from a 10-day to a 5-day competition
- o At this time we still don't have the smoking gun, confirmed involvement of Nike in the bid process
- Our legal council is \$300 an hour
- o <u>ACTION</u>: Leave grievance open until a definitive answer is provided about the awarding of the 2012 Olympic trials
- Youth grievances
 - o Napa vs. Palo Alto Lightning closed
 - o UMOJA vs. athlete on their team closed
- LDR grievance
 - No word from the national office that the LDR grievance was escalated to the national office so assuming at this time that issue is closed

Nominations

- It's time to nominate PA members for the 2010-2011 Executive BOA's position
- President position must be back-filled because Jerry has now served two consecutive terms
- Secretary, Treasurer, Vice Chair first two-year term will expire this year. These positions can be renewed or another can run against the incumbent
- Either nominate yourself or someone else who is a current 2009 PA/USATF member. Nominations must be made and seconded (if you e-mail a nomination to the PA office ... ensure someone else e-mails a second to the PA office)
- Motion and second for Lloyd Stephenson (treasurer) and Maura Kent (secretary) to be placed on the ballot for the next 2-year cycle

Background Checks

- George Paddeck is updating the list every 2 weeks through July
- March 31 is the deadline to renew USATF membership; after this date anyone who had a LiveScan from last year will have to pay our of their own pocket to renew
- As of today, 79 PA members have cleared
- USATF National Office is changing the types of crimes that need to be tracked; list is getting bigger ... all involve a conviction
- PA process for tracking offenders is better than the one in place by USATF so PA will continue to manage a process separate from the rest of the other associations
- If a person is excluded by the PA based on results then the excluded individual has the right to appeal to the national office
- Charlie Sheppard doesn't have bandwidth to continue with the creation of the photo ID cards
- ACTION: Charlie to train Debra Harvey who is taking over the process
- <u>ACTION</u>: Charlie to provide a list of all approved LiveScan folks he still needs a digital headshot
- <u>ACTION</u>: Debra to contact John Mansoor to determine what equipment she needs
- <u>ACTION</u>: Maura Kent to write up an article for CTRN to educate youth athletes about their LiveScan and why their coach's need to pass

- <u>ACTION</u>: BOA needs to add to by-laws the protocol on how youth will handle a coach who doesn't clear
- <u>ACTION</u>: At each youth meet print a list of clubs and their coaches / parent volunteers who have cleared
- <u>ACTION</u>: Augment future budgets to allow for postage / envelopes to mail cards to recipients

- Pod thanked everyone for submitting their responses back in such a timely manner
- Summary article submitted to CTRN and made the most recent issue

2009 JO XC Nationals

- Proceeding along well
- Need coordinator for the opening ceremonies
- Jim Vanden-Huevel committed to giving each youth competitor a minted medallion from the Carson Mint; this is financially prohibitive so John Mansoor is working on another medallion at a lower cost
- Grappling with chip timing Bob Shor has recommended a company that John will investigate
- <u>ACTION</u>: Maura to draft a document to be linked from the icon Cynci had created for the DyeStatCal website

 - o Eugene, OR has the bid
 - Current environment for athletes results in excessive travel, poor longterm planning by athletes and their coaches
 - National relay program will be discontinued
 - o American coach & athletes under utilize the USATF available coaching area
 - Need to create a program / training centers to develop athletes
 - o Blog or e-mail Doug Logan if you have ideas
- Major focus areas that each breakout great should consider how to implement programs that will focus on these deliverables
 - o Junior Olympics (2009 XC and 2010 T&F) ... right in our own backyard
 - o Masters (national & world) ... right in our own backyard
 - o Athlete development ... dovetail with Project 30
- Within eight years it is hypothesized that all high school sports teams will cease to exist and the European model for high school sports ... compete on a club team instead of a school team
