

USATF has announced that the Rock 'n' Roll San Diego Marathon/Half Marathon, 5/31/2015, will host the 2015 USATF Masters Half Marathon Championships.

For the second time in 2015, Pacific Association Masters runners need only travel to Southern California for a national Masters road championship.

Registration for the event is \$100.

Complimentary entries are available for runners who have achieved an 85% or better age-graded performance in a half marathon in 2014 or 2015, based on the official WMA/USATF 2010 Age Grading Standards.

Comp entries may also be available for runners who have an 85% or better in a 15 km or longer distance during 2014 or 2015 at the discretion of the games committee.
