## Air Travel Information

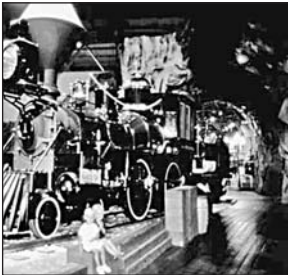

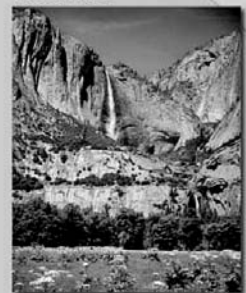

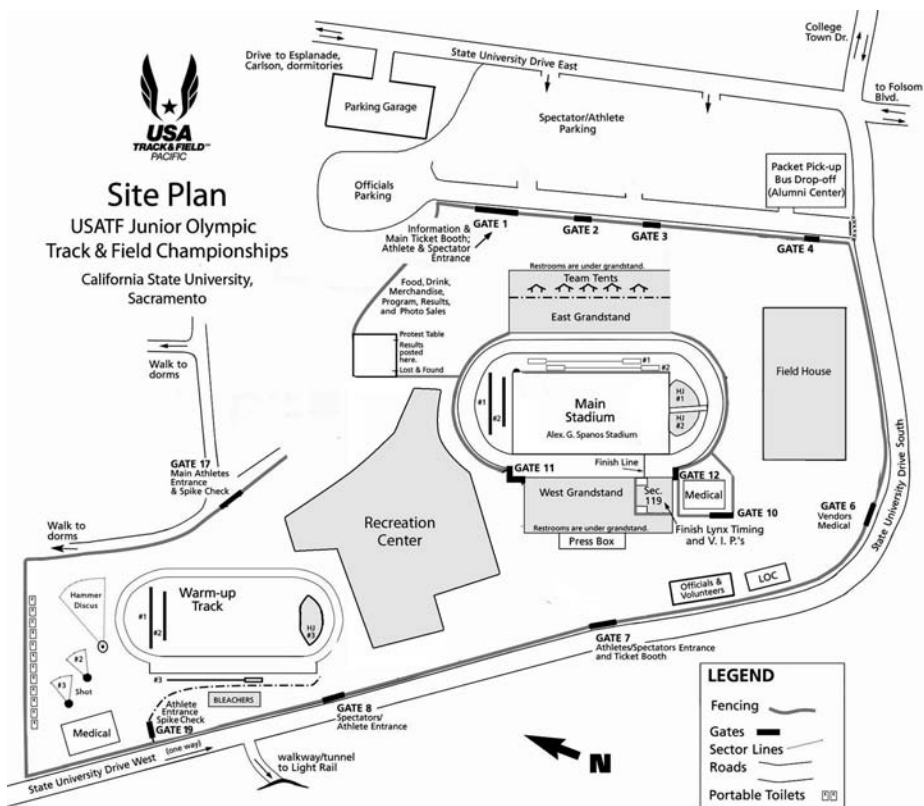
