Race Walking Committee

Results of the USATF-Pacific Grand Prix races are posted on the website at http://www.pausatf.org/race-walking/. The 2015 season ended with a 20-km road race on October 25 in Carmichael/Sacramento. After the race, Grand Prix awards (reflective shirts, hats, and gloves) were given to the winners.

Team Awards (total of best five scores of the six Grand Prix races – 50 points maximum):

First Place - Sierra Race Walkers (43 points)

Second Place - Marin Race Walkers (35 points)

Third Place - Pacific Racewalkers Organization (26 points)

Age-Graded Individuals (average of top four percentages, 100% = top speed in the world at that person's age)

First Place - Mark Green (83.95%)

Second Place - Karen Stoyanowski (83.65%)

Third Place – Joanne Figone (80.57%)

Men Overall (total of best four scores by speed – 40 points maximum):

First Place – Tied – Mark Green and Alex Price (39 points)

Third Place – Mark Kaiser (32 points)

Women Overall (total of best four scores by speed – 40 points maximum):

First Place - Robyn Stevens (40 points)

Second Place - Karen Stoyanowski (38 points)

Third Place – Joanne Figone (33 points)

Competitions for the 2016 Pacific Association Grand Prix will likely include 1-mile (January 23 at Cal-Berkeley), 3,000-meter (May 14 at Mount Diablo High School in Concord), 5,000-meter (in association with the Pacific Association Open Track and Field Championships), and 1-hour races on the track and 10-kilometer and 20-kilometer races on a road course (in Carmichael/Sacramento).

The USATF annual meeting should be interesting from the race walking perspective, because an item up for discussion will be implementation of a new IAAF rule about a "pit lane" or penalty box, initially for youth. Whether it will be used in the National JOs in Sacramento might be decided at that time. If so, it will require many more volunteers (two runners for each of the five judges) and extra officials (to run the pit lane).

2015 Awards Banquet

Strawberry Canyon TC (with a big assist from Irene Herman) will host the banquet at the Hunan Restaurant in San Francisco, tentative date -2/21/16.

Road Grand Prix:

- 2015 10 of 13 races completed, no open protests
- AADP Phillip Reid and Alycia Cridebring each received a \$500 grant to cover expenses incurred while running in a national championship. Phillip ran at the USATF 10 Mile Championships in Minneapolis (part of the Twin Cities weekend of races), where he came in 18th, running a PR of 49:07. Alycia ran 16:35, to finish 15th at the USA 5 km Championships (CVS Health Downtown 5K).
- 2016 bids for the following races have been approved: NorCal 10 Mile, SACTOWN 10 Mile, Marin Memorial Day 10K, Freedom Fest 5K, Marin Miracle Mile, SVTT 5K and CIM. The TherX 5K and CCC 12K decided not to submit bids for 2016.

XC Grand Prix:

- 8 of 10 meets completed, no open protests
- Preparations continue for hosting the 2015 USATF National Club Cross Country Championships. The PA XC Championships on 11/22 will serve as a test run for the 3 courses to be used for National Championships (6k, 8K & 10K). I will video the PA races and will be putting together time-lapse videos of the three courses by attaching a GoPro camera to the lead cyclist. I've been very active on the Masters Road GP Circuit this fall and can tell you **many** runners are looking forward to coming to the event. Think dry thoughts for next weekend and the later part of December.

Ultra Grand Prix:

This from Bill Dodson referring to a project to modify the code used to score the PA Road and XC GPs so that it can also be used to score a MUT GP.

We are working on specifications for use by whoever develops the program to do the 2016 Ultra/MUT standings like those for the Road and XC Grand Prix's. This is made more complex by what we think is a need to change some of the GP rules. We will develop proposals for these changes to be approved by the LDR executive committee since there is not enough time to go through the standard two LDR meeting process.

Since next year is the 25th anniversary of the Ultra Grand Prix, we hope to keep the same set of races for 2016. Beginning with 2017 we think the Ultra Grand Prix should become the MUT Grand Prix with the possible revision of the ultra set of races and gradual addition of sub ultra mountain runs.

Hollis and Bill will complete our tenures with the 2016 Awards Banquet and pass the committee chairmanship on to someone else.
