Pacific Association Level 1 Schools

The Pacific Association's Level 1 School is completed for the season having education 57 coaches while offering 6 scholarships. There was discussion of hosting an association Level 1 in the Sacramento area mid-August, in addition to the 14-15 January, 2018 (*MLK weekend*) at Chabot College. National Level 2 School

The 2017 Level 2 School will be 17-22 July at CSU Fullerton, Southern California. Application should open early March. The Pacific Foundation will offer two partial scholarships for the school. Check the Coaches Committee page mid-February.

SafeSport Training

USATF has joined the United States Olympic Committee (USOC) to implement the SafeSport program. The goal of SafeSport is to provide a safe environment in our sport at all levels, but particularly for athletes who are ages 18 and under. The SafeSport program includes athlete protection policies, guidelines, codes of conduct, a background screening program, education and training, and a reporting process for any SafeSport concerns within our sport.

All Officials and Youth Club Coaches and Volunteers will need to complete the SafeSport Program. You may complete the SafeSport training on line (*with quizzes interspersed through training*). For more information on the USOC SafeSport Training course, refer to: <u>http://safesport.org/</u>
