Culture

- Team Culture starts at the top
 - Truly begins from the bottom up
 - Peanut taught me that in order to build a program, you have to start working on your Frosh-Soph Team!

Caring Atmosphere

- "They will never care how much you know, until they know how much you care!"
 - First thing we established at Vista was a place where kids felt "safe."
 - We talk to our kids about things other than running
 - Practice is a sanctuary
 - Our team is a Family

Fun Atmosphere

- Without running being fun, they will quit or find another sport
 - Too many options today for kids
 - We have to "Win" them over

 - Camp!
 - Donut Days
 - Photo Scavenger Hunt
 - Theme Days
 - Flag Short Friday

 - Run-A-Thon Theme Runs

Successful Atmosphere

- We concentrate on the "process" NOT the "outcome."
 - We define success as doing all the little things on a daily basis that will make them better.
 - Did they stretch?
 - Did they do their Core?
 - Did they do their injury prevention exercises?
 - Did they get enough sleep the night before?
 - Did they log their miles on xcstats?

Successful Atmosphere

- We concentrate on the "process" NOT the "outcome."
 - We define success as doing all the little things on a daily basis that will make them better.
 - Did they do everything possible today to make themselves better tomorrow?
 - Did they run the workout "as prescribed?"
 - Did they do everything they could to get to the starting line prepared both mentally and physically?

Successful Atmosphere

- We concentrate on the "process" NOT the "outcome."
 - We do NOT pay attention to whatever anyone else is doing.
 - We cannot control what others are doing. We can only control what "WE" are doing.

Successful Atmosphere

- We concentrate on the "process" NOT the "outcome."
 - We celebrate the victories we have each day.
 - I really get excited for the kids when they do all the things we ask
 - We find the positives in each days workout
 - Cannot judge success based on their place in a race.
 Cannot control their competition. Can only control certain things.....And too many things are out of their control

Cohesive Atmosphere

- Cross Country is a great team sport, but as coaches we cannot control the closeness of their relationships. That has to come from within the team.
 - So what do we do to bring the team together?

Cohesive Atmosphere

- We select team leaders.
 - We attempt to teach the leaders that their role is to make everyone on the team a leader.
 - Must choose these leaders very carefully.

• Pre-Race Circle and Relaxed Breathing

Cohesive Atmosphere

- Team Stretching/Rolling/Rehab Time
 - Most important 30 minutes of practice to build a cohesive group.
 - Would be easier to leave practice, but this is the time they "really" come together!

Cohesive Atmosphere

- Making "Big" feel "Small."
 - Split athletes amongst coaching staff
 - I want every athlete to feel they are getting individual attention
 - The "Fist Bump!"

Building Traditions

- I have the kids start traditions.....with my help.
 - My job is to keep these going

Building Traditions

- Flag Short Friday
- Crazy socks on road trip shake out run
- Getting dressed up for dinner on road trip
- Alumni Christmas Run
- After League Finals the entire team goes to pizza
- Letters from Alumni to team night before State Meet

Building Traditions

- End of the year banquet is about "team" and "Seniors."
 - Senior Speeches
 - Let's younger kids know what the program is really all about!
