- B. Training Clinics (Bill/Jim)
  - 1. Jan. 20 @ ARC
  - 2. Feb. 3 @ Chico
  - 3. Feb. 11 @ Serra
  - 4. Short a few instructors HJ @ ARC & Serra (Podkaminer?); Leica @ ARC & Serra; Vertical Jumps for ARC Intro.; LDR (Rick & Kathi Berman); Umpire & Clerking.
  - Dave Shrock to do SafeSport at ARC and Serra; Dave Soeth to do Weights & Measures
- C. Rulebooks (Ajay/Jim)
  - Should we offer rulebooks to newbie officials free of charge or only if they signup/pay for them in advance?
    - a. Jim suggests giving them the URLs and so they can buy their own rulebooks.
  - 2. What, if anything, should we charge for workshops at ARC/Chico/Serra?
    - a. Consensus is we need to charge. Bill suggests \$10/class. Moved: John Shirey; second: Shirley. Passed
  - 3. **Note**, we have already decided NOT to charge for newbie classes as newbies are already in for \$46 (\$30 USATF membership and \$16 for NCSI background check.)
- D. Certification (Jim)
  - 1. 20 have expressed interest in becoming certified
  - 2. SafeSport has redone entrance into their site. Must take SafeSport once per Olympiad.
  - 3. Will push for newbies to have membership & NCSI background check complete before attending clinic
  - 4. Report: Numbers game 259 members
    - a. Invoices for payment of Cert/ReCert fees



- b. 11 bodies didn't complete certification but have Official ID #s
- c. 127 need to get Officials numbers; encouraged to sign up for multiple years
- E. Awards (Leon)

### V. Old Business

- A. Update of NCAA D1 Regional Meeting Preparations (Phil)
  - Has contacted Nathan Smurdon about officials who have expressed interest.
    Deadline is December X
    - a. NCAA will assign Referees, Starters and Chiefs. PA Officials will assign event crews.
- B. Cal Officials Plaques (Shirley)
  - 1. Shirley has given them a 2017 list of names.
  - 2. Plaques still aren't done. Cal is "still working on it".

### VI. New Business

- A. College Stipends for Officials (Shirley)
  - Now that Cal is paying officials they are not contributing to our PA Officials
     Committee budget. ARC and SF State also pay officials. Davis provides lunch for the
     Annual Meeting.
  - 2. John Shirey stated he believes that schools at which we officiate should contribute to our budget. George said only 3 schools have ever contributed to our budget.
  - 3. John suggested that Phil send a bill/letter of intent to the schools requesting donations.
- B. Officials Mentor program from Bill Bartel: Do we plan to continue the program?
  - 1. Have not had officials volunteer to head up the program.
  - 2. Could have Head of Event do a post event review/discussion of the event to give feedback to new official or someone learning a new event.
  - 3. Shirey suggests we need a new model if we are to revive the program.
  - 4. In the Introduction to Officiating Clinic, Mike Bower informs the new officials how to get involved in a meet at a particular school. There was extensive discussion about the best way to assign a new official to an event. Most often the Officials' Coordinator at a school is a coach.
  - 5. John Shirey to pull together the information.

  - 2. One election for National Certification Chair with 1 candidate: Roger Burbage.
