Hello everyone!! The Pacific Association of USA Track and Field (USATF) welcomes you to the 8th Annual Shor-Sheppard Classic Track and Field meet. This year the competition will be held on a 2-day schedule; Saturday and Sunday June 22nd and 23rd at De Anza High School near Richmond. There are no other Pacific Association 2-day meets between the PAC meet in early June and the Region 16 meet in early July. And sorry, but DeAnza HS cannot accommodate pole vault and javelin. We're working on rectifying this problem for 2020.

This meet was started to honor two wonderful men who dedicated their lives to us all for the benefit of our youth in the Pacific Association and beyond. Bob Shor has now departed but Charlie Sheppard is still here with us and we pray for his continued good health. Let's now take this opportunity to remember these two great men of USATF Pacific Association youth track & field!

The main purpose of the Shor-Sheppard Classic is for the benefit of active graduating seniors from the Pacific Association. We're looking forward to offering grants annually to four graduating PAUSATF seniors, a male and female in track and a male and female in field. We originally planned to start this year, but it is now changed to start in 2020. The amount will be between \$500 and \$1,000; depending on proceeds from the meet. We're currently working on establishing who will work on this committee to make those determinations. More information is forthcoming.

Pacific Association USATF 8th Annual Shor-Sheppard Classic

- Cost: \$\frac{\$4 per event, \$16 per relay}{}\$ (no refunds after close of meet)
 - o 6 & under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12 year olds, can enter 1-3 events
 - o 13-14, 15-16, 17-18 year olds can enter 1-4 events
 - o Athletes are not allowed to compete in an older or younger age group
 - o A relay counts as an event
 - Unattached athletes cannot form a relay team
- The 15-16, 17-18 age groups are no longer allowed any false starts. 6 & under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 age groups are still allowed one false start
