SafeSport Update:

Everyone's SafeSport training is good until 31 December, 2020 From that point, everyone will have to update their training:

- 1) For those who took the original face-to-face training will have to take the new SafeSport Core Training on-line or available face-to-face at the Reno Annual Meeting. The Core training will be good for 1 year, then these official will have to take a a 30min on-line refresher course.
- 2) For those who have more recently taken the SafeSport Core Training, you will only need to take an annual 30min on-line refresher course annually beginning in 2021.
