U.S.A. Track & Field, Pacific Association officials will be hosting this “Introduction to Track & Field Officiating” clinic. Upon completion, you’ll become an Apprentice-level USATF Official, certified to officiate High School, College, and USATF Youth, Open, and Masters Track and Field.

The clinic is free; however, to become a certified official you must, **before the class,** complete the following:

- First, join USATF online at <https://legacy.usatf.org/membership/application/index.asp> USATF membership can be purchased for one year and will cost **\$30.00**. Your first year’s membership is good through December 31, 2020.
- Second, once you have your USATF member number, complete the background check at <https://www.usatf.org/safesport/background-screening>. Next, click on the Officials Background Screen icon (bottom left.) Enter your USATF membership number and the password you entered when you joined USATF. The cost of the background check is **\$16.00**, and it is valid for two years.
- Third, take the SafeSport training, online at <https://uscenterforsafesport.org/> or <https://uscenterforsafesport.org/training-and-education/training-and-education-services/> As a member of USATF, the \$20 fee for this approximately 90-minute training is **waived**. Use your membership number when taking this training. The email contains attached instructions to guide you through the process.

Be sure to bring a copy of the confirmation/receipt from NCSI that your background check was completed or email the confirmation/receipt to Jim Hume (jimhume@comcast.net) before January 25.

Also please bring a copy of the confirmation from SafeSport, which you will receive upon completion of the SafeSport training online or email the confirmation/receipt to Jim Hume (jimhume@comcast.net).

P.S. – Walk-in candidates will be accommodated if we have internet access and several laptops available for immediate completion of the USATF membership application as well as completion of the NCIS background check if they have not been previously completed. A credit card will be required for this. SafeSport will not be required to be completed at that time, but please complete as soon as possible.

P.S.S. – If you are a USATF-certified coach or official (for example, as a Long Distance Running or Race Walk Official) who has a current NCSI background check and SafeSport, you are most welcome to take this clinic.

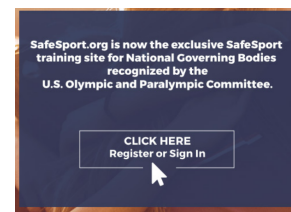
