	I, II, III	Create NCAA sport specific Rules Book 'Parts' and renumber. I = Indoor, II = Outdoor, III = Cross Country.
	I:1, II:9, III:17	Create a Rule within each sport section containing the 'definitions' used within that section.
**	I:4-5, II:12-5, III:20-6	Specifically define the primary role and the duties of the Jury of Appeals when one is appointed.
**	I:4-17, II:12-18	Medical personnel decision to allow re-entry to competition after a medial re-exam is without appeal.
	i:5-2.6, II:13-2.6	Recommendation to create flights in C.E. vertical jumps when more than 12 competitors
**	I:5-4.3, II:13-4.3	Allows vertical jump competitions to use a single continuous flight under any circumstances. Choosing another option is not mandated.
	I:5-5.4, II:13-5.4 III:21-2	Scoring report contents clarified
	I:6-2, II:14-2	Time schedule changes preventing competitor participation is not 'failure to participate'.
**	i:6-3.1, II:14-3.1	Viewing, outside the competition area, of a previous field event trial is allowed. Crossing the track must be supervised after first track event.
	i:6-4.5, II:14-4.5	Allow bib number in jumping events to be worn by competitor choice on either front or back.
	I:7-9.7	For indoor 3000m, Require the possible use of a timed-section final if more than 20 instead of 16.
**	i:8-1.4, II:16-1.4	Jumping event and Javelin warm-up approaches can only be taken in the direction event is conducted.
**	i:8-1.10, II:16-1.10	Clarify procedure for field event measurement and the preservation of landing mark.
**	I:8-1.14, II:16-1.15	An official shall monitor all field event warm-up areas and periods.
**	I:8-3.2, II:16-3.2	Requires the vaulting pole to be planted in the vaulting take-off box for a jump to be legal.
**	I:8-4.4, II:16-4.4	Take-off in LJ / TJ cannot be outside the runway.
**	I:8-5.2, I:8-6.2,	II:16-5.2, II:16-6.2, II:16-8.2 Fouls clarified in circle throwing events. (back half of circle)
	II:10-5	Depth of water-jump in Steeplechase reduced for new construction.
	II:16.2	Attempt time-limit chart reformatted.
	III:21-6.3	Clarifies the process for scoring in Cross Country.
	I:5-3, II:13-3	Delete Field Event Time limit and Guaranteed Measurement alternate procedures.
