January 1 - December 31: Renew your Background Screening. The renewal deadline varies by individual. Your Background Screening expires two years from the date of your last screening. Login to <u>your "USATF Connect" account</u> to determine your Background Screening status.

January 1 - December 31: Renew your SafeSport training. SafeSport training is now an annual requirement, meaning it should be completed once every 365 days. Login to <u>your "USATF Connect" account</u> to determine your SafeSport status.
