Welcome to the PAUSATF Officials Training Clinics 2023. There is A LOT of information here. PLEASE take the time to read this document carefully. To sign up for any clinic or All-Comers meet, please respond to this email, or send a separate email to training@pacific.usatf.org Please indicate the date, time, and specific clinics and/or All-Comer meets you would like to attend. On January 21 and January 28, you are able to take two clinics each day (three if you include Rules Review), one in the morning and one in the afternoon. Sign up for as many or as few clinics as you like. All are free of charge. While it is good manners to sign up in advance, you do not have to do so to attend any clinic.

If you plan to Officiate or Mentor at any of the All-Comer meets, also contact the appropriate coordinator(s).

CLINIC DESCRIPTIONS

Introduction to <u>Horizontal Jumps</u>, <u>Vertical Jumps</u> or <u>Throws</u>: Each of these stand-alone clinics will cover the basics of each event such as pre-meet preparation, rules, measurement techniques, positions, how to perform the duties of those positions up to and including the position of Flight Coordinator, and post-meet responsibilities. If you have just completed the Introduction to Track & Field clinic, you should be signing up for these. Clinics are at Cordova H.S., Carlmont H.S., and Sacramento State. See dates below.

Advanced <u>Horizontal Jumps</u>, <u>Vertical Jumps</u> or <u>Throws</u>: Each of these stand-alone clinics are designed for officials who are ready to be Crew Chiefs. These classes will cover items such as pre-meet preparations, pre-event preparations, event duties, and post-event duties. Clinics are at Cordova H.S., Carlmont H.S., and Sacramento State. See dates below.

Apprentice Starter: For those who are interested in becoming Starters or are inexperienced Starters and want a refresher on the basics of Starting. Starter's pistols may be provided. Some training may include the use of an <u>E</u>lectronic <u>S</u>tarting <u>D</u>evice. Although designed for Apprentice Starters, all levels of starters are welcome. Apprentice Starter training will be held at the Grant All-Comers, Vanden All-Comers, Los Gatos All-Comers, and the Chico Starters Clinic. See dates below.

Advanced Starter: Topics to be discussed or employed include setting up a "dual alley" start; positions for recalling an event; understanding the SIS system; controlling the start area; giving instruction to, and adjusting to, various levels of competition; dealing with televised meets; obtaining a block crew; understanding the "zero gun test;" working with announcers; being prepared for a record; and starting cross-country meets at various levels. Although designed for Advanced Starters, all levels of starters are welcome. Advanced Starter training will be held at the Cal All-Comers meets and the Chico Starters Clinics. See dates below.
