

## USATF *Pacific* Board of Athletics Meeting Tuesday, 15 November, 2022 - 7:30-9:30pm *Unapproved*

- 2. Approval of Sept. 18 meeting minutes: Angie Longworth unapproved posted online
- 3. Treasurer's Report Jason Mawdsley John Mansoor
  - a. Ed Hollshwandner makes a motion to amend the Youth club meet grant budget (line item 91) from proposed 2023 level of \$1500 back to the 2022 level up to \$2500, Deborah Sample seconds it. Vote 15 approve, no voted no, no abstain. Motion passes to increase to budget. Ed and Jason discuss various issues including Youth clubs sanctioning and tightening up rules for grants and eligibility. Ed mentions that Youth operating procedure rewrite this winter is forthcoming.
  - b. 2022 balance sheet, once we have concluded disbursements and revenues we will have a surplus of roughly \$23,000. Had projected a deficit of (\$20,214). The delta is attributed to Youth committee doing a phenomenal job of controlling expense and bringing in revenue this year, the Master's T&F committee having an event that brought in \$7,000, income from investments brought in \$10,000, a 1 time sale of timing equipment and some 1 time grants round out the delta.
  - c. Burnet Lux from Umoja Track Club, youth believes we should move budget to a percentage basis for distribution of funds.
  - d. Ed H. would like to have the budget viewed as operational expense/ income and keep the investment side on a separate report. Have a cash P&L statement and have a separate investment report.
  - e. We will table to budget vote until we resolve the open items (coaches and Ed's motion).

- 5. USATF Pacific Foundation update John Shirey

- a. A year ago we changed the athlete grant program to have 2 cycles of awards (1 for T&F and 1 for marathoners) Mia Weagle, Amy Schantz and Brendan Greg. All 3 are entered in CIM. In September we have officer elections. Exactly the same people. Michelle Vasalo, Rick Berman, Stephanie Trafton (secretary) and John Shirey as President. 2 new board members, Lisa Bowden, David Sander. Said goodbye to board member- Jay Abbot. We will be kicking off our fall fundraiser. Looking to raise \$12,000 to fund our athletes next year. Note, the foundation does not get money from the association, it stands along to bring in its own money.
- 6. Association Celebration Banquet (4 Feb) update Irene Herman
  - a. Call for award nominations Ryan Cowley/Leroy Milam (Officials), will also need LDR nominations, coaches, and Youth awards. In addition to committee awards we have Association wide awards.
  - b. Food is a Chinese banquet in south city. Will get application for registration in Mid-December.
- 7. Youth Update Deborah Sample/Cris Houston
  - a. Deborah- submitted schedule for 2023 T&F. Debra will work with clubs to ensure they are in compliance with requirements, and will work with clubs if they want to host an event.
  - b. Cris concluding the XC season this weekend. Have had several. XC Championships in Willow Hills this weekend. 408 athletes registered for the association championship. Believe the grand prix is a great motivator for participation. May have to restructure to focus on participation instead of competition. How to recognize participation.
- 8. Officials Update Phil Leake
  - a. Got applications in for NCAA West regional, selections should be made by the first. If you want to officiate at this meet get your name into the NCAA now.
  - b. Rick Berman has done a great job of getting officials for LDR Grand Prix and Club Nationals.
  - c. Finalizing dates and times of clinics this next week.
  - d. Phil's proxy at annual meeting is Dennis Boyle.
- 9. 2022 Associations Grant Update Ryan Cowley, Dave Shrock, JR Heberle: \$2000 to purchase EDM-long distance measuring device for field events. Ryan will learn how to operate. Ryan has started to learn how to use. Shawn Laughlin donated a laptop to use with the EDM device. JR will offer training sessions. Tori submitted for associations grant for the RJT event for 2023 (was not approved for this cycle).
- 10. Grow to Impact association activities Charlotte Sneed, we were granted \$5000. We used part of the of the money to purchase an OWL device to use in hybrid meetings, and a promo booth at CIF T&F Champs.
  - a. John suggests putting A frames with info at the college meets. Stanford, SF State, Sac State, Berkeley. We have budget for marketing and it could be used for this.
  - b. Ed H. suggests putting the A frames at HS Sectionals. Charlotte remarked that we did do that this year.
  - c. Charlotte asks that members send her ideas of how to use future grow to Impact funds.

  - PAXC Championship this weekend. Strawberry Canyon TC providing volunteers. Three races. 5 miler for 40+ men, expect over 400 people. Use this as the prequel to the Nationals on 9 Dec. also at GG Park.
- d. Club Cross in SF Golden Gate Park, Dec 10 Irene Herman
  - Will have race walking demonstration at packet pickup.
  - All hotels have met the room bookings.
  - PAUSATF will host race party at Hotel for no cost. Will get DJ in and let West Valley run the party.
  - Andy Crawford and Carl Rose are co-directing the race event.
- e. 2024 Master's T&F Championships in Sacramento and D2 National XC at Haggin Oaks
  - Amanda Tentatively RD for T&F event. Danielle is the race director for XC D2
  - NCAA west region D1 T&F as Sac State, NCAA D1 West Region XC at Haggin Oaks.
