Level 1 Reimbursement

The Pacific Board of Athletics and Youth Committee is providing \$100.00 reimbursement for any PA Youth club coach who attends a Level 1 School from 1 Jan'22 to 31 Dec'23.

Eligibility: Coaches must be 1) 3 step compliant at time of Level 1 completion, and at time of reimbursement request, 2) Coaches must be actively coaching with an accredited USATF Pacific Youth Club, 3) Coaches must complete google docs reimbursement form, 4) Provide Level 1 certificate of completion within this timeframe.

Pacific Association Coaches Badges

Through a grant obtained from the National Association Committee and the efforts of LaDonna Aubert working to design and create these badges, you may be eligible to obtain a Registered Pacific Coaches Badge to wear at all events to better protect our athletes and to control access to competition areas. To be eligible for this badge you must be 3-step compliant: 1) 2023 membership, 2) current SafeSport, 3) NCSI current background check, 4) color photograph loaded onto your Connect 80 membership profile. 15 March to 14 March: Association Office elections: President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer

Eligibility and Nominations:

Nominator and nominees must be 3-step complaint at time of nomination. Nominations made electronically must be sent to the Association Executive Director at pausatf@aol.com (please cc secretary@pacific.usatf.org) with the candidate name, officer position, and names of the nominator and a seconder from the Board of Athletics. Elections will be conducted for one month for contested positions. All officers assume their positions 1 June.

14 March – 16 May Association Committee elections: All committees may self-nominate for positions on all committees with the exception of Officials that vote in August.

Nominator and nominees must be 3-step complaint at time of nomination. Nominations made electronically must be sent to the Association Executive Director at pausatf@aol.com (please cc secretary@pacific.usatf.org) with the candidate name, committee position, and names of the nominator.

16 May BoA meeting nominations close and elections will be conducted for one month for contested positions. New officers transition into their positions upon confirmation of election, though not later than 31 August. Youth has eleven positions open for nomination/election!
